

Albion Yard Waste Collection Policy

The Town of Albion's Yard Waste Collection Policy has been implemented to help instruct the resident's of the Town of Albion on the approved methods of disposing of yard waste. We appreciate your cooperation.

We **<u>will not</u>** remove the following:

- Whole trees
- Tree stumps
- Whole bushes
- Grass clippings
- Vegetative Debris, including Weeds, Garden Waste, Dead Flowers, Potted Plants and Cultivated Plants or Crops
- Dirt
- Rocks
- Sod

County Composting Site

The county composting site is located 1.5 miles east of S.R. 9 on county road 100 N. Please obey all rules posted at the site regarding what materials are accepted.

Collection Dates – Every Monday from April thru November. (If Monday falls on a holiday, collection will be the following day.) We **will** remove the following yard waste, if found in a reasonable amount*:

- Tree limbs
- Brush
- Leaves (SEE BELOW)

*A reasonable amount is one pile no larger than 4ft x 3ft x 3ft. Tree limbs must be no larger than six (6) inches in diameter.

Tree limbs and brush will not be collected if piles are greater than the aforementioned size requirement.

Tree limbs and brush must be kept **separate** from leaves and other debris.

Leaves

During Fall LEAF PICKUP

Leaves must be raked to the curb or edge of street, if no curb is present. **DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO STREET.** If leaves are raked into the street, they will not be collected until raked back behind the curb or edge of street by the resident. Raking leaves into the street is unsafe. Children like to play in leaves. A child could be injured by a passing vehicle, if unseen by a motorist. Leaves that are placed in the street can also plug storm drains. This will cause flooding, if storm water catch basins are plugged.

After LEAF PICKUP

Leaves must be bagged in order to be collected. Bags shall not weigh over 30 lbs and shall not contain other debris.

In the event of a storm or other emergency, exceptions to this policy may apply.
